Parking at the Curzon Centre
New Restrictions in Place

We do realise that parking is difficult outside the school and we ask that parents park considerately both in the morning and after school to ensure the safety of our children and out of respect to our local residents.

Parking at the Curzon Centre

Following a meeting with the new management of the Curzon Centre, we have been made aware that some parents are still using the Curzon Centre car park. They have requested that we reiterate to all parents that parking for drop off/pick up for **both school and Curlaround** is prohibited. **The car park is strictly for users of the Curzon Centre only and should not be used by parents at any time.**

In addition, there have been reports of parents being aggressive towards Curzon Centre staff when they have been approached and reminded not to park there. We respectfully request that parents are polite and considerate to our neighbours at all times.

The management is potentially planning to install ANPR cameras to ensure only users of the Curzon Centre facilities are parking on its site. Customers using the Curzon Centre will be able to register their vehicle; any other vehicles will automatically receive a fine of up to £85.

Other Parking Restrictions

- Please do not park on the **corner of Maxwell Road and Garvin Avenue** as this makes it difficult for our children to see to cross the road safely.
- Please do not park on the **grass areas and across the drives of our local residents' houses or in resident only areas.**
- Please do not park **in front of the school gates** at any time during the school day to drop children off. This poses several problems, ranging from a danger to children walking behind a car that may be reversing, to deliveries and visitors being unable to enter the school's car park, which in turn blocks Maxwell Road. In addition, this access point must be kept clear in the event of an emergency.
- Please do not park **on or opposite the zigzags outside the school** as this obstructs the view of the children trying to cross the road.

As part of the school's Travel Plan, we would encourage parents and children to walk to school whenever possible. On the occasions when you must use a car we suggest you park away from the school, Sainsbury's has kindly agreed to allow our parents to park from 8.30–9.15am and 3.00–3.45 pm on the top level of the Sainsbury's Car Park.

We ask that you please support these important safety guidelines. The school and Governors are working with the County and local Police Community Support Officer to make the area around our school safer for your children.
