**Y3 and Y4 Bikeability Cycle Training Course**  
**Friday 14<sup>th</sup> October 2022**

The school has received funding for a Level 1 Bikeability Cycle Training Course for 48 children in Year 3 and Year 4. The course will take place in small groups during the normal school day. The course is designed to give children new skills and develop their confidence cycling; please note, **children must be able to ride a bike without stabilisers in order to take part**. Although funding has been granted from Buckinghamshire County Council, we still require an additional £5 per child in order for your child to take part. The training will be delivered by fully-qualified instructors from BeSpoke Cycling Instruction.

If you wish to book a place for your child, please complete the attached consent form from BeSpoke Cycling and make payment via your ParentMail account. Bookings for this course open via ParentMail at 7pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September and places are limited to the first 48 children to book. A waiting list will be maintained should anyone drop out and spaces will be offered according to the date/time added to the list, so please ensure you add your child to the list if you would like a place but are unsuccessful in the first instance.

Please ensure you read the letter from BeSpoke Cycling as it provides further information on the equipment requirements for this course, as well as the consent form for you to complete and return. **Please only return the form if you are successful in gaining a place for your child.**
